SCC INCREASES CEMENT SALES

Saudi Cement Company's total cement sales during the first 8 months of year 2013 equaled to 6,129,968 tons. The local sales quantity reported during the first 8 months of 2013 was at 6,013,018 tons compared to 5,534,727 tons during the same period of previous year 2012 i.e. an increase of 478,291 tons equivalent to 8.64%. Further, SCC achieved the largest local market share of 15.9% out of 15 local cement companies during January to August 2013.

Local demand for cement in Saudi Arabia has increased during the first 8 months of 2013, as it reached to about 38 million tons compared to 35.5 million tons during the same period of previous year 2012 i.e. an increase of 1.5 million tons equivalent to 7%. Furthermore, due to import of clinker by local cement companies, the closing stock of clinker as of August 2013 stood at about 8.7 million tons compared to 5.9 million tons during the same period of year 2012 i.e. an increase of 2.8 million tons equivalent to 47%.
